### Project Description

Administered by the Federal Highway Administration, this project is a complete reconstruction of 3.9 miles and an asphalt overlay of 0.4 miles of US Hwy 212 between Cooke City, MT and the NE entrance to Yellowstone Park. The project is located entirely within the state of Montana. Awarded to Oftedal Construction on July 16, 2007, the contract amount is \$15,702,152. Major items of work on the project include grading, sub excavation and replacement, gravel and plant mix surfacing, and a water line feeding Cooke City.

Work began on this project in the fall of 2007, and will continue until its scheduled completion date of September 25, 2009. Due to the record amount of snowfall this past winter (2007-2008), major construction activities did not begin in earnest until mid-June 2008.
