Project Description

The largest highway contract in Wyoming history at \$65,299,681 was awarded to Oftedal Construction on May 30, 2008. This project is a complete reconstruction of 16.3 miles of US Hwy 26 between Dubois, WY and Moran Junction which is 30 miles north of Jackson Hole. The project traverses the continental divide over scenic Togwotee pass (elev. 9658'). The schedule for the project indicates major items of work progressing over three seasons (2008, 2009 & 2010) with a chip seal applied in 2011.

Oftedal's project team will be headed by Brad Olson as Project Manager and Jim Wilcox as Superintendent. Jim's experience as Supt. on the reconstruction of the adjacent Brook's Lake section in 2006 & 2007 will be invaluable as will Brad's experience managing various WYDOT jobs around the state. WYDOT has indicated they will be utilizing the same team as they did on the Brooks Lake job as well, which is a very professional and dedicated group. A major goal for both teams during construction is to minimize delays to motorists traveling through the jobsite.
